The entrees for the 1972 California QSO Party was far less then that of 1971. Perhaps the rule changes were the cause of it, and maybe not. Separate logs for each band and mode may require additional time and work, but it is easier on the committee for checking. Besides it helps in preventing duplicate QSO's. It wasn't necessary to keep consecutive QSO numbers; separate numbering for each log would have been OK. The 48 hours gives an opportunity to have two evenings to work the QSO party.

No separate awards were given to Novices this year. Each novice QSO was worth five points and the Novice got five points for every QSO regardless who it was made with. Besides, some of these stations were winners for their sections.

This probably will be the last time I operated from Sierra County since I have worked most who need a Sierra County QSL. If I return next year I will not be using WA6JDT since it will expire in September.

I would like to give credit to Dean, WAØTKJ, for the effort in the party. As for QSO count, Dean was exceeded only by WB6KBK, (based on the logs received).
