#### **CQP 2023 CA County Report**

This report shows the CQP 2023 top 10 QSO makers in every CA county. Stations who did *not* submit a log **are** included in this report. The report is sorted by # of callsigns active in a given county (from one callsign active to >10 callsigns active).

#### Purpose:

- Show how many callsigns really were active in CQP 2023 by county, including stations that did not submit a log.
- Identify counties that are reliant on just one or two stations.
- Inspire all of us into action. CQP 2023 had the best county coverage in CQP history. However, with the data below, it is easy to imagine how CQP 2024 could be the first year since 1985 where no stations outside CA achieve a county sweep. We need your help to make a positive impact in CQP 2024!

#### Conclusions:

- 57 out of 58 CA counties had two or more callsigns active in CQP 2023. All 58 CA counties had coverage on CW & SSB.
- Just one station in any county can have a huge impact on the entire contest. Be that station in CQP 2024!
- Several counties that were easy to contact in CQP 2023 are at high risk of being rare in CQP 2024. See below for details.
- Casual, fixed stations listed below can suddenly become the primary station in 2024. They are gold mines. Contact these stations and offer to partner with them in different ways: Expedition on their property? Remote? RIB (radio in box)? S/O guest op? M/S with you offering to be the CW op? Mentor? Lend equipment? Don't wait for the CQP Chairman to play matchmaker. Reach out and make a connection!

CQP Chair comments: We have relied fully on portable operations to activate Glenn County. There are outstanding expedition opportunities on public lands in the western part of the county and decent mobile terrain through farmland in the eastern part of the county. Over the past 20 years, only one fixed station has ever activated Glenn County and submitted a log: WA6FWN in 2021. A look at his page on qrz.com shows this station could be an effective way to activate Glenn County. A willing contester might consider exploring a remote partnership with this station for CQP. His qrz.com page suggests he has good computer skills with presumably a decent Internet connection at his QTH. Both are benefits to successfully pulling off a remote activation.

CQP Chair comments: Imperial County has been activated in CQP by expedition for as long as I can remember. For many years, the K6QK expedition team (N7CW, K6ZH and team) has been the primary force in the county. This team is much like the Modoc County expedition team: motivated, reliable, well-equipped and great contesters who make a lot of QSOs. However, the K6QK team was unable to operate for three years recently. Fortunately, other individuals and groups stepped up in a big way and mounted their own expeditions to Imperial County. 2023 brought a return to the familiar Imperial County results table, where the K6QK expedition was the main QSO maker. But like the Modoc County expedition team, we cannot expect this to last forever. Who will take the reins in the long term and become the next consistent expedition in this county? Also, fixed stations are an untapped resource in this county. A motivated contester should propose a partnership with KM6NUY and the Imperial Valley Amateur Radio Group club station. KA6ASF made some QSOs from his home station in CQP 2022. Remote partnership opportunities?

CQP Chair comments: Sierra County is the 2nd least populated county in California with just over 3,000 residents. W6MY has a loud fixed station in the county with a low noise floor and is a generous station owner proven to be willing to host guest operators over the years. This station should be utilized every year on SSB and CW with the assistance of a guest operator. Sierra County also has excellent opportunities for expeditions on public land, including county line points. N7AUE and N7AAE operated as expeditions and submitted checklogs. They did a great job and we hope they go to their same expedition spot in CQP 2024.

CQP Chair comments: Alpine County is California's least populous county at just over 1,000 total residents. 96% of the area in Alpine County is public land. Mobile operations are unproductive due to mountains surrounding main roads. Expeditions are required to keep this county active in CQP. The county's mountainous terrain on public land allows excellent opportunities for expedition operations, but wind and snow can ruin expedition plans at high elevations. Therefore, it is important to plan more than one expedition station in Alpine County every year.

CQP Chair comments: Trinity County is the 5th least populated county in CA. Gorgeous surroundings with vast USFS and BLM land make this county prime for expeditions. The presence of a few Airbnbs also helps with expedition possibilities. Mobiles are unlikely to be successful due to mountainous terrain surrounding the main highways. Expeditions are what have made this county QRV every year. Expeditions by N6DVS (on CW) and K6KS (on SSB) have been vital the last several years in a row in Trinity County. We need to do everything we can to support them so that they continue to activate this county by expedition.

CQP Chair comments: Colusa County is similar to Glenn County with respect to geography, area and low population. The geography in the eastern part of the county is conducive for mobile success. Colusa County is one of only three CA counties in CQP 2023 where mobile stations made more than 20% of the county's QSO total. The terrain in the western part of the county provides opportunities for expeditions on USFS land. AF6GA has saved Colusa County by being the only expedition presence for the last three years, but we need to allow him the opportunity for a change of scenery to activate a different county in CQP 2024. Who will step up to organize an expedition to Colusa County in 2024?

CQP Chair comments: Mendocino County used to be highly reliant on expeditions in CQP. In the last few years, we've been very fortunate to have WA6M@W6DSR and KB6LZW as active fixed stations. A look at the K5RR qrz.com page also shows a very capable HF antenna. This is an untapped resource that could be explored. How can we continue the momentum of these fixed stations in CQP? Finally, expeditioners looking for an operating location in the county should find ample opportunities. The MEND/GLEN county line is on USFS land with great downsloping terrain. K6EI found a hilltop opportunity with Airbnb creature comforts that is likely available for CQP 2024. If we take advantage of both fixed and expedition opportunities, there's no reason why this county should be rare in CQP.
